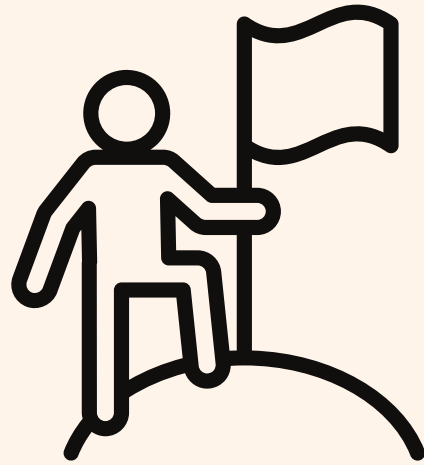

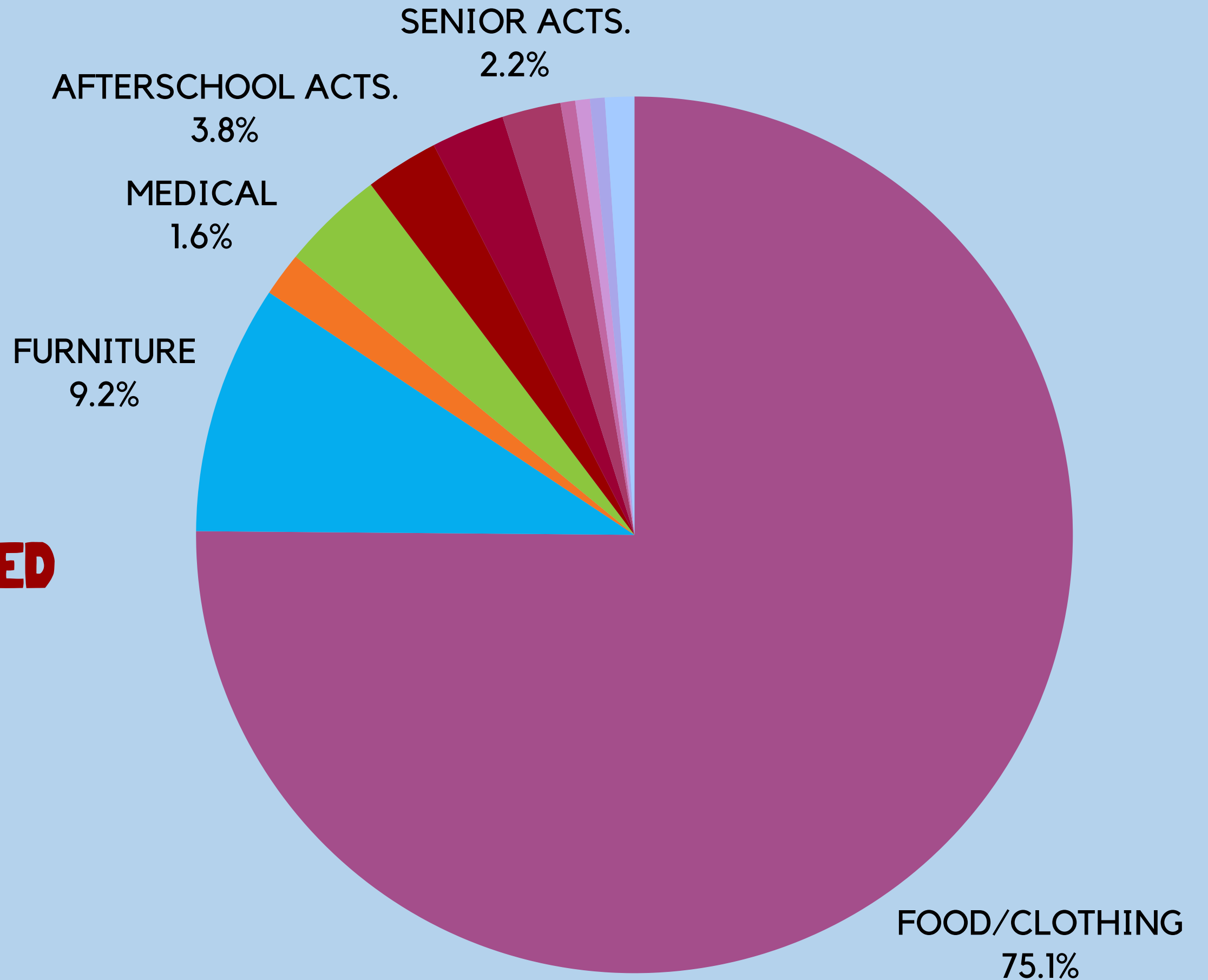
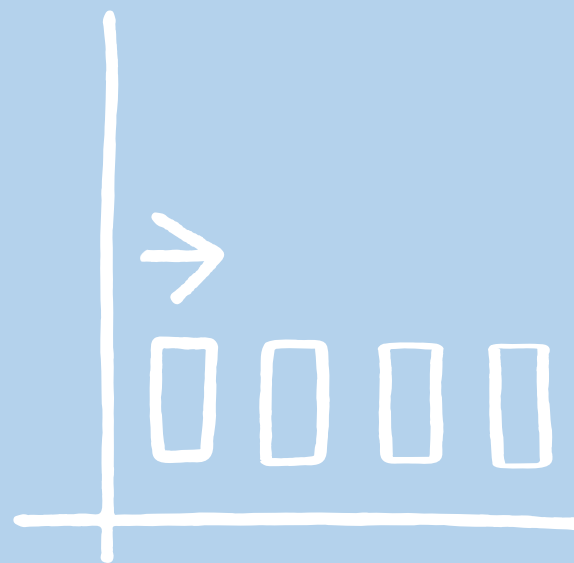
Our Children's Needs Program provides funding for children in foster care to assist with basic necessities, normalcy and dignity items and experiences.

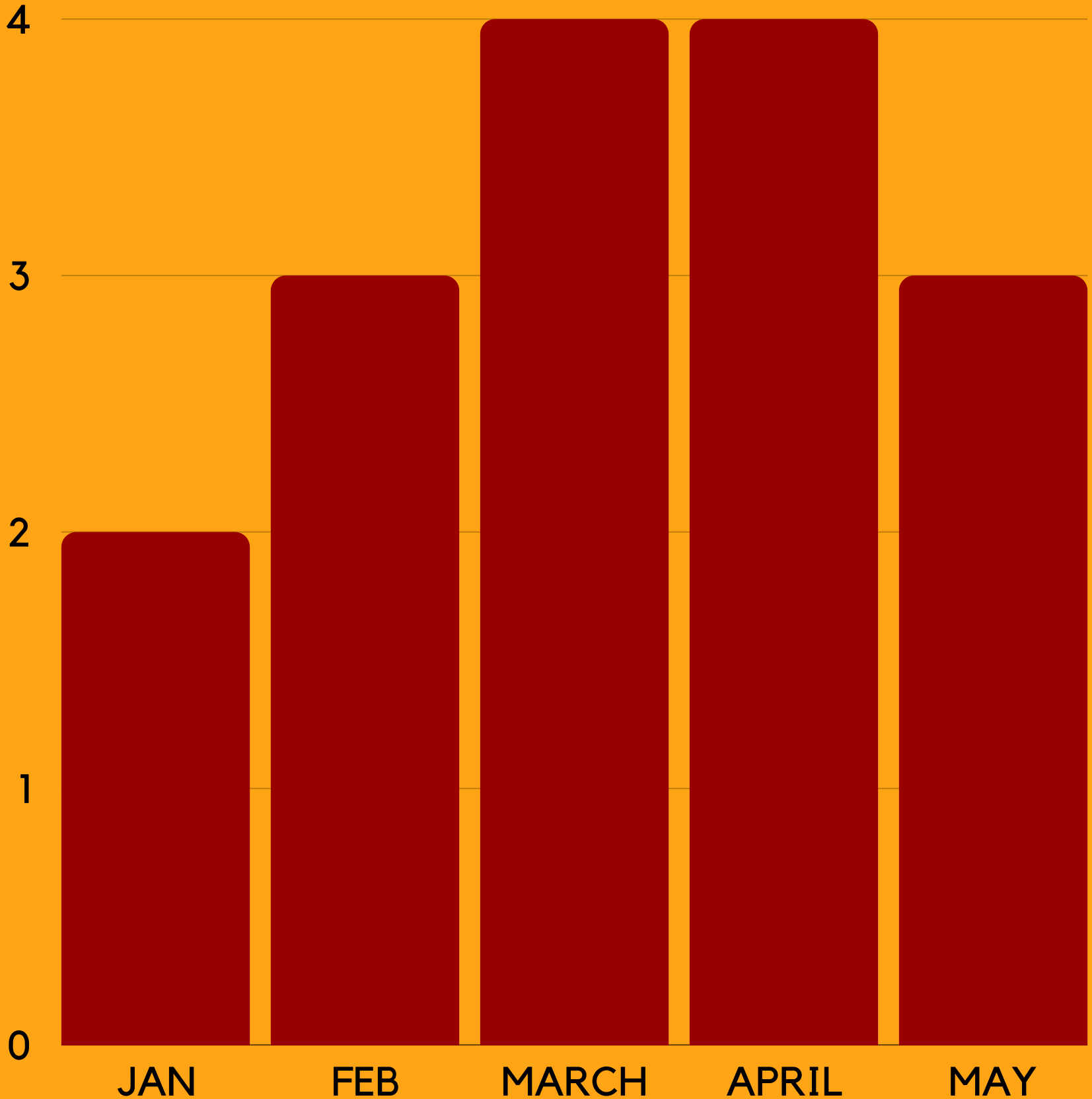

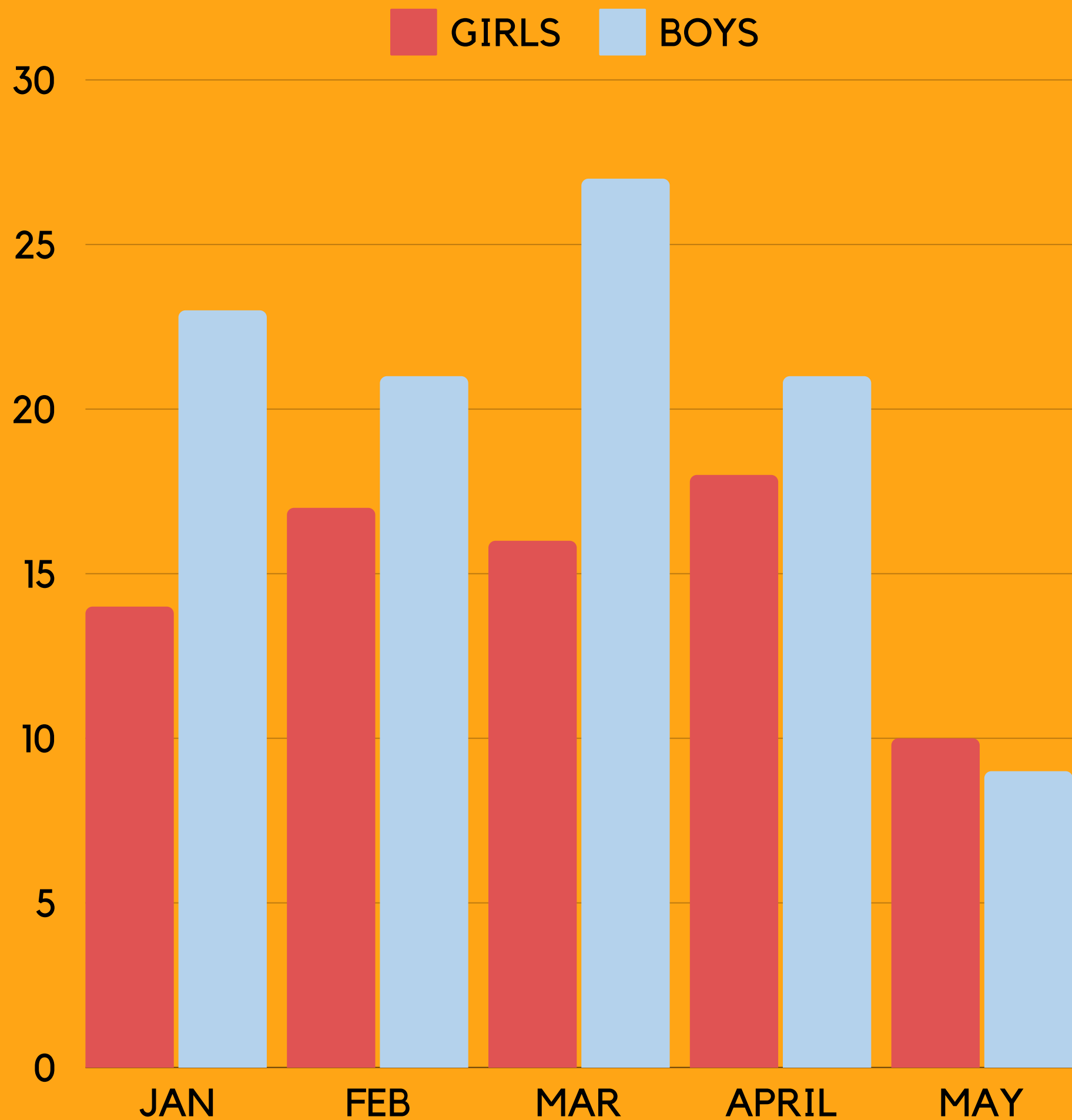
